

Leland Auxiliary Police Commander Greg Gilbert passed away at the end of June, leaving a deep loss for our Village family.



Greg served Leland for 22 years with quiet dedication, humility, and integrity, making the long drive from Arlington Heights simply because he loved serving this community. As our longest-serving employee, Greg made a lasting impact, not just through his work, but through the kind of man he was. He mentored younger officers, supported his colleagues, and stepped in wherever he was needed. ORDINANCE CORNER:

It shall be unlawful to:

- Inhumanely beat, underfeed, overload or abandon any animal.
- Fail to provide any animal with proper shelter, protection from weather or veterinary care when needed to prevent suffering. (Ord.6-2-2)
- Keep on the premises more than four (4) dogs or cats or any combination thereof over four (4) months of age, or more than two (2) such animals boarded for compensation or kept for sale with the exception of regularly established and zoned veterinary hospitals, pet shops, pounds or shelters. (Ord. 6-2-3)
