THE VILLAGE IS IN THE PROCESS OF REPLACING AND ADDING STREET SIGNS THROUGHOUT TOWN. MANY OF OUR EXISTING SIGNS ARE FADED, UNREADABLE, MISSING, OR NOT PLACED IN THE CORRECT LOCATIONS. THIS PROJECT WILL HELP ENSURE CLEAR NAVIGATION, IMPROVE SAFETY, AND A MORE CONSISTENT LOOK ACROSS THE COMMUNITY




ORDINANCE CORNER:

Over the last few months, the Village has received concerns about vehicles exceeding the allowable weight limits. After careful consideration, the Village Board has passed a revision to the parking ordinance, Title 11 Article A Section 6 (11-5A-6), increasing permitted vehicles up to 16,000 pounds (an F-plate) in side and rear yards and only one of the following shall be allowed: recreational vehicles including motorized home, boat trailer with or without a boat mounted on it, but no stand alone boat or unmounted boat; commercial vehicles when owned by or issued to the occupant, except semi-tractors, semi-tractor trailers, construction equipment, and any vehicle with a gross vehicle weight in excess of sixteen thousand (16,000) pounds. We want to give residents time to adjust to this new restriction, therefore, enforcement of this ordinance will begin on January 1, 2026. Thank you for your understanding.
