WALKABILITY SURVEY

The Village of Leland is applying for a grant through the Illinois Department of Transportation. This grant is called Illinois Transportation Enhancement Program (ITEP) and if awarded, the money would help pay for:

- Improved sidewalk conditions (cracks, heaving, too narrow, etc.)
- ADA compliant sidewalks (ramps and traction improvements at road intersections)
- Trees and landscaping around our downtown sidewalks
- Improved lighting
