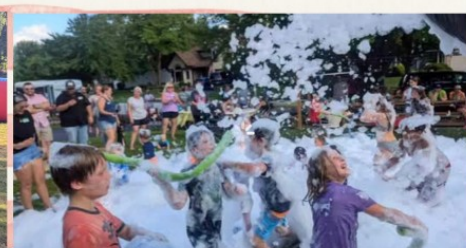
For more than a year, the Village of Leland has been planning a special celebration to honor America's 250th birthday.

ORDINANCE CORNER:

5-5-2: HEIGHT RESTRICTION PLANTS, WEEDS, & GRASS:

It shall be unlawful for anyone to permit any weeds, grass or plants, other than trees, bushes, flowers or other ornamental plants, to grow to a height exceeding six inches (6") anywhere in the village. (Ord. 06-12, 7-3-2012)
